
Activity Suggestions for *Dreamstones*

1. Inukshuks

- use geometric nets to make a variety of 3D shapes such as cubes, rectangular prisms and cones
- first colour the nets to resemble stones using black, grey, white or brown pencil crayons
- carefully cut out the nets, make the folds and tape together
- assemble the 3D shapes to make Inukshuks using glue or tape

2. Arctic Animal Facts

- choose an Arctic animal and complete a mini research project
- try to learn about the animal's food, protection, home, defense and classification
- some suggested topics are penguins, caribou, elk, Arctic foxes, whales, puffins, seals, polar bears, walrus, turns

3. Marvelous Mittens

- cut oversized mitten shapes from bristol board, two per child
- provide a variety of bits and pieces to use to decorate the mittens
- suggested materials might include wool, scraps of fabric, felt, sequins, glitter, buttons, ribbon, stickers, glitter glue, foam shapes, pom poms and any other treasures you might have
